

## **Grendon Underwood Parish Council (GUPC) Meeting 27/04/26**

### **Saye and Sele Foundation Report**

At a meeting of the foundation on 20/04/26 the following items relevant to GU were discussed :-

#### **Playground lease variation**

Trustees viewed the area of concern and I pointed out the various boundaries. It was agreed that the GUPC lease variation should not include any area within the “community area” part of which is outside the V Hall boundary as defined by the land registry.( Title Number BM294930) The area outside the V hall boundary is within the Saye and Sele boundary as defined by a 1936 conveyancing plan. (Application to the Land Registry to register the Saye and Sele land at GU is ongoing)

It was agreed that ,subject to PC agreement, I would ask Mr Abbott to amend his plan of the proposed amendment to exclude any area within the “community area” but to include the small piece of ground on which the dog and general waste bins are situated.

The Saye and Sele clerk will draft a letter to the V Hall Trustees concerning the continuing use of the part of the “community area” outside the v hall boundary and within the Saye and Sele boundary.

#### **Parish Council appointed Trustee**

The need for GUPC to appoint a Trustee was confirmed, and it was suggested that the Grendon School FROGS might put forward a suitable person and/or that a Teaching Assistant resident in the village could be considered. I agreed to mention this at the PC meeting as this initiative will need to come from GUPC (not the Charity) in accordance with the Scheme of the Charity.

#### **Grants**

One individual grant was agreed, and one was declined- both were for GU residents.

#### **Finance report**

A finance report was reviewed which included the effect of the Iran conflict on investments and confirmation that in the first quarter of 2026 we had awarded 8 grants to a total of £4950 .
